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The Voyeur Alain Robbe Grillet

The Voyeur (Le Voyeur) was Robbe-Grillet's second published work. Much like The Erasers, The Voyeur deconstructs a genre story (murder mystery) into a set of descriptions and commonplaces, freeing the crime itself from any psychology or motive.
